

# **An Post-Election Open Letter to Past and Current Leaders of ABC Unified School District**

November 5, 2014

Dear Community Leader:

The 2014 general election is over. Voters in the ABC School District have defeated Measure AA, sending a strong message that they reject irresponsible taxation and wasteful spending. We hope this message has been heard loud and clear by all.

In the aftermath of the election, we welcome any conciliatory overture from the District. We would be more than happy to sit down with representatives of the District and the community to discuss matters of mutual concern, and to explore ways to improve their relationship. Issues we would like to discuss include but are not limited to

1. Proper disposal of contributions to “Yes on Measure AA for ABC Schools” campaign.
2. Exact nature and amount of taxpayers’ debt obligations to the 1997 modernization bond.
3. Detailed list of all 1997 modernization projects, including the cost, work order, warranty, inspection reports, maintenance records, etc. of each project for each school.
4. Evaluation of District policy to actively recruit out-of-district students.
5. School facilities need assessment based on demographic reality and projections.
6. Sensible plans for surplus school facilities due to enrollment decline.
7. Availability and appropriation of all sources of school funding.

We remain hopeful that a sincere and candid dialog between the District and representatives of the community based on mutual respect and trust will produce positive results and make our community a better place for everyone.
